NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING NTC FARE ADJUSTMENT AND ROUTING CHANGE

May 20, 2013 at 9:30 a.m.

(VVTA) will hold a public hearing at VVTA's Offices located at 17150 Smoketree Street, Hesperia, CA to accept testimony on the proposed fare changes for the NTC Commuter, creation of a VVTA MEGA-Pass and a limited "on base" shuttle. Interested persons may attend the meeting to submit oral testimony. VVTA will also accept phone and written testimony. Please send comments to the VVTA address above, info@vvta.org or call 760-948-4021 (TDD 760-948-3990). Accommodation for persons with disabilities will be made.

VVTA MEGA-PASS

Currently VVTA has no pass that is good for 31 consecutive days on all of its services, excepting vanpools and Direct Access. The BV-Link offers no passes other than a day pass. Each segment of the BV-Link costs \$6.00. Those segments are NTC to Barstow – Barstow to Victorville – Victorville to San Bernardino Valley and Metrolink. Currently the monthly round trip cost to ride the BV-Link every day it operates from Barstow through to San Bernardino is \$360.00. The VVTA MEGA-PASS will offer a significant savings.

- The fare for the VVTA MEGA-PASS will be \$175.00 for a 31 day pass, this pass will replace the current NTC Commuter monthly pass of \$200 from Victorville and \$150.00 from Barstow;
- 2. The VVTA MEGA-PASS is valid for 31 consecutive days from the first day of use;
- 3. An elderly and disabled MEGA-PASS may be purchased for half price (\$87.50);
 - a. Current VVTA rules apply including showing identification for pass purchase and upon boarding a bus;
- 4. The VVTA MEGA-PASS are accepted for fare an all VVTA services excepting vanpools and Direct Access;
 - a. These include fixed route, county routes, all BV-Link routes and segments, NTC Commuter, and VVTA Commuter shuttle;
- 5. VVTA MEGA-PASS may be purchased with cash or credit card at valid VVTA pass sales locations;

- a. VVTA cannot accept MTBP special debit cards for purchase of VVTA MEGA-PASS;
- 6. Additional transit services will be added from time to time.

Military NTC Pass Fares & Passes

- 1. The new fare is \$245.00 for a 31 day pass from Victorville or Barstow;
 - a. The one way cash fare on all NTC Commuter buses is \$12.00 each way from Victorville and Barstow with no reduced fare available;

- 2. All reduced fares will be discontinued per FTA Half Fare Rule;
 - a. Reference 49 USC Chapter 53, Federal Transit Laws; 49 CFR 609 Transportation for Elderly and handicapped; and FTA C 9030. 1C Urbanized Area Formula Program: Grant Application Instructions;
- 3. Military 31 Day Passes will only be issued from special vending machines conveniently located on Base;
 - a. The only payment accepted for these passes is the MTBP debit card;
- 4. Military 31 Day Passes are accepted for fare on all VVTA services excepting vanpools and Direct Access;
 - a. These include fixed route, county routes, all BV-Link routes & segments, NTC Commuter, and VVTA Commuter shuttle;
- 5. Since Military ID's are checked for issuance of an MTBP debit card VVTA riders using a Military 31 Day Pass will not be required to present VVTA additional military identification.

Recently the federal government restored the Mass Transit Benefit Plan (MTBP) back to \$245.00 per month from \$125.00 per month. The out of pocket cost to those eligible for the MTBP will be nil.

NTC Commuter Fares

- VVTA will eliminate the current monthly NTC Commuter passes from Victorville and Barstow to Fort Irwin and replace them with the VVTA MEGA-PASS;
- 2. VVTA will replace the one way cash fare of \$10.00 from Victorville and \$8.00 from Barstow with a \$12.00 fare for any one way ride on the NTC Commuter;
- 3. VVTA will eliminate all reduced cash fares on the NTC Commuter per FTA Half Fare Rule;
 - a. Reference 49 USC Chapter 53, Federal Transit Laws; 49 CFR 609 Transportation for Elderly and handicapped; and FTA C 9030. 1C Urbanized Area Formula Program: Grant Application Instructions.
